Parent Partnership & Choice Service

Impartial information, advice and support for parents of children with Special Educational Needs aged between 2 and 19 years old and impartial information and advice for all parents on making the transition from primary to secondary school

Children & Family Centres

A range of courses and drop-in sessions for parents and their children aged between 0 to 5 years on Child Development, School Readiness, Family Support & Parenting, Health & Wellbeing and Skills Acquisition as well as quality play sessions and other additional provision for parents of children of primary school age

Bromley Safeguarding Continuum of Need & Intervention

VULNERABLE CHILD WITH ACUTE OR HIGHLY COMPLEX NEEDS

Has suffered or is at risk of suffering significant harm/significant impairment to health or development

Bromley Children Project *Complex Family Support Case*

Child on Child Protection Plan, working with Social Worker on a specific issue as described in Plan

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VULNERABLE CHILD WITH MULTIPLE AND COMPLEX NEEDS

Bromley Children Project *Family Support Case*

CAF or Child in Need level. Possibly in role of Lead Professional, working with colleagues from other agencies supporting family's needs. Undertaking Initial Family Assessment, Planning and Review

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VULNERABLE CHILD WITH SOME ADDITIONAL NEEDS

Bromley Children Project or Parent Partnership & Choice Service

Family Support Case (non-CAF) In role of Lead Professional. Undertaking Family Assessment, Planning and Review
